



Job Title: Child Therapist (Part-time, contract-based, 1099)

Job Summary: The GreenHouse Child Advocacy & Sexual Assault Center is seeking a part-time, contract-based child therapist to provide Trauma-Focused Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) to children and youth victims of sexual abuse and to supportive caregivers. The GreenHouse serves both Whitfield and Murray counties. All services will be provided through The GreenHouse CAC/SAC. Bilingual preferred.

Supervisor(s): Director of Victim Services;
With clinical supervision provided by the Clinical Services Coordinator

Basic Duties:

Provide therapy services to child victims of sexual or extreme physical abuse.

- Receive therapy referral reports
- Provide trauma-focused-behavior-therapy or another form of evidence-based therapy to school-aged youth.
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with related agencies, multi-disciplinary team review members, and other organizations to coordinate activities, identification, and utilization of resources.
- Complete all required documentation according to CACGA and The GreenHouse standards.
- Maintain adequate and updated documentation in client management software.
- Communicate with the Advocate and Director of Victim Services to ensure prompt and consistent therapy appointments.
- Participate in monthly supervision with the Clinical Services Coordinator and Director of Victim Services, providing updates and input on client progress.

Skills

- Strong written and verbal communication skills (both English and Spanish preferred)
- Ability to work effectively in a team environment
- Working knowledge of the child welfare and legal system
- Skilled at building collaborative relationships with others (clients, caregivers, coworkers, and professionals from other agencies and organizations)
- Commitment to cultural competency
- Coordinate with custodial caregivers to deliver services conducive to their schedules (including evening and after-school hours).

Education

- Master's degree from an accredited university in a mental health field required.
- To be considered for this position, all candidates must have a current or be in the process of obtaining State of Georgia licensure (LAPC, LPC, LMSW, LCSW or LMFT), and must maintain active licensure.
- Availability and willingness to participate in continuing education as required by the State of Georgia, Child Advocacy Centers of Georgia, and the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council
- Fingerprint background check required.
